RCP works to hire staff who are nurturing of children's development. RCP Staff also undertake hours of professional development to keep up to date on the latest research and methods in child care.
- 3. Activities and Curriculum: Look for programs that offer a balanced mix of academic support, recreational activities, and opportunities for social interaction. This helps children stay engaged and continue learning outside school hours. In RCP's School Age Program, the educators work diligently to create curriculum that gives the children the room to engage in unique and thought provoking activities. They provide homework support and are open to making connections and working collaboratively with the children's public school teachers. RCP curriculum provides a strong focus on STEAM curriculum. - 4. **Communication**: The program should have clear lines of communication with parents, providing regular updates on your child's progress and activities.
